- Word Work: We will be reviewing all word families from this 9 weeks
- Read and spell Sight Words: him, our, another, been, did, just
- Retell stories, including Key details & demonstrate understanding of message
- Describe characters, setting & major events in a story
- Identify words and phrases in stories or poems that suggest feelings or appeal to the senses.
- Compare & contrast the adventures and experiences of characters in a story
